7	Proof of available lodging in Europe <u>to visit family and friends</u> : offer of hospitality - as per the form Proof of Sponsorship and/or Private Accommodation (please see Forms webpage)	<input type="checkbox"/>	
8	Proof of economic means of support: updated bank statement, transactions list of the last 3 months showing the applicant's name (same as on passport)	<input type="checkbox"/>	
9	Marriage or de facto certificate (if you are married or in a de facto relationship)	<input type="checkbox"/>	
10	Travel insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 30,000. Certificate of insurance with Table of Benefits or Product Policy Disclosure. If using a travel insurance through a credit card provider: certificate of insurance from the bank, letter from the bank confirming eligibility, copy of credit card and table of benefits. (The travel insurance must be covering the cost of repatriation for medical reasons, urgent medical treatment or hospitalization or costs incurred in the event of applicant's death while in the Schengen area.
